To whom it may concern,

I am writing this reference at the request of Jennifer Lee, who is applying for a scholarship.

I met Jennifer in 2019 in my capacity as an associate professor of management of information systems at the Faculty of Business at Athabasca University in Canada. She took two of my undergraduate courses: Information technology leadership (CMIS431) and information technology project management (MGSC 419). CMIS431 explores the role of information technology (IT) leadership, especially that provided by the Chief information officer. The course covers IT leaders' issues, activities, and responsibilities in delivering value to organizations through information technology. MGSC419 teaches the fundamental concepts of project planning and organization, budgeting and control, and project life cycles by distinguishing information technology projects from traditional projects. The students learn organizational workflow, including the staffing process and project communication, and tools and techniques for planning and tracking the project.

Jennifer handed out excellent works in both courses by scoring the highest grades. Based on hard work, curiosity, willingness to follow instructions, I would rate Jennifer's academic performance as excellent. At my best knowledge, I do not know anything that can prevent her from reaching her educational objectives. Suppose her performance in my class is any indication of how she will succeed in her future educational endeavors. In that case, Jennifer will be a positive addition to the program, not only for the quality of her work but for her eager curiosity and desire to apply class materials to solve real-world problems.
